

Livingston – Internal Isolocork Application

TRAINING SESSION | PROJECT CASE STUDY



Internal Isolocork application carried out in Livingston during a practical training session.

Project Overview

This internal application in Livingston was completed as part of a practical Isolocork training session. The exercise gave the applicator hands-on experience with spray technique, coverage, working around openings and corners, and building a consistent textured cork finish across internal wall surfaces.

Training Application

The session focused on controlled spray application to internal wall areas. The photographs show the material being applied with a hopper gun and the progression from the prepared board surface to an even cork-textured finish. Attention was given to coverage around window openings, edges and returns.

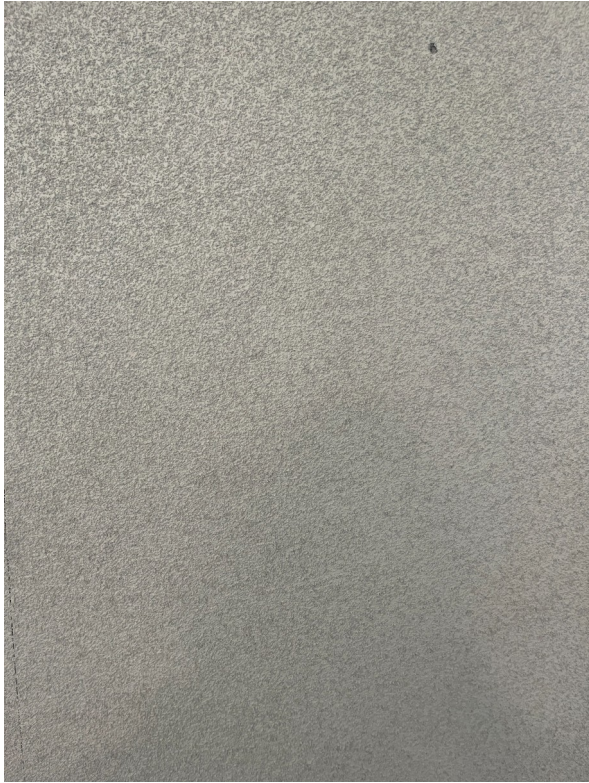

Application Result

The training areas show the characteristic continuous textured appearance of Isolocork across wall faces, corners and openings. This was a practical training exercise rather than a completed occupied-room refurbishment.

Finish Detail

Close-up photographs show the granular cork texture produced by the spray application and the way the finish follows corners and junctions.



System Used

Isolocork spray cork was used as the internal sprayed finish. The session was structured as practical applicator training, allowing the application method and finished texture to be demonstrated on a real internal construction area.

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
